HOME GROWN CHARITY CELEBRATES 10 YEAR MILESTONE

Peace of Mind Foundation marks ten years as Australia's largest brain cancer support charity

Peace of Mind Foundation is celebrating its 10th year of supporting thousands of brain cancer patients and families across the country with an Anniversary Celebration on Thursday 16 November in Geelong.

The Foundation was established to fill a much-needed gap in the support of brain cancer patients by siblings Clint Matthews and Rebecca Mallett. Created in honour of Clint's wife Caroline Matthews, who passed away on her 32nd birthday in 2011, Peace of Mind Foundation set out in 2013 with a vision of ensuring every family in Australia impacted by brain cancer would have access to the support they need.

From humble beginnings in Geelong, Peace of Mind Foundation now supports over 800 families nationwide diagnosed with brain cancer every year, and demand for its services are growing rapidly.

Founder and CEO of Peace of Mind Foundation Rebecca Mallett said she is incredibly proud of the impactful support the Foundation is now delivering to patients and their loved ones.

"Over the last decade, our Foundation has evolved to give support, courage and community to brain cancer patients, their carers, family and loved ones from diagnosis to bereavement, helping them navigate the many challenges they face in crisis.

As we've grown, we've experienced increased demand from the brain cancer community to access our expanding suite of services and programs on offer. We've also seen increasing referral rates from the medical community, who entrust us with the supportive care of their patients outside of a medical environment."

"We consider it a privilege to be able to help impact survivorship and quality of life for all of our patients diagnosed with this dire disease and we thank every single individual, community group and partner brain cancer charity who have supported us along the way," she said.
